Dear Sir/Madam,

Please refer to letter with DO No. MD-SBM/RS/8/2016 dated 26th May 2016, as per the letter the ULBs can utilize Capacity Building and A&OE funds allocated under SBM for meeting the expenditure for a period of 06 months for implementation of an ICT based solution for tracking of municipal vehicles developed by BSNL or MTNL or DIMTS.

As ULBs have to deploy ICT based solution for tracking of municipal vehicles carrying solid waste to secure high marks in Swachh Survekshan 2017, because of this many ULBs also have implemented or are implementing standalone solutions of tracking of municipal vehicles.

In view of this, the ministry has decided that the ULBs can meet the expense from the Capacity Building and A&OE fund allocated to the ULB under SBM **for implementation of solution for tracking of municipal vehicles of even if it is not from BSNL or MTNL or DIMTS.** The expenses will be funded for a period of 06 months not exceeding Rs 1500 per vehicle per month. The ULBs also has to ensure that the city level solution for tracking of Municipal Vehicles is integrated with the eSBM platform (<http://esbm.bsnl.in/>) and the information / bin cleaning status of the city is available on this platform.

The Capacity Building fund of SBM has to be utilized for enhancement of capabilities of the ULB level functionaries and augmentation of capacity of ULBs.

In view of this, implementation of solution of tracking of municipal vehicles at city level will give hands on experience to ULB employees for using the digital platform for Solid Waste Management (SWM) thereby leading to capacity augmentation of the

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ULB functionalities. Therefore, it is proposed that the capacity building fund of SBM be used for this purpose.

ULBs are requested to take cognizance of this and leverage usage of ICT in SWM.
