सिटी डेवलपमेंट प्लान पर कार्रवाई शुरू

■ सात दिन में तैयार होगी निरीक्षण रिपोर्ट

■ सीवर, ड्रेनेज, यातायात का विस्तार मुख्य बिन्दु

विभिन्न शासकीय विभागों को इस संदर्भ में निर्देश दिए हैं। दिल्ली की विशेषज्ञ संस्था मैनेजमेंट डेवलपमेंट कंसल्टेंट (एमडीपी) को आगरा का सीडीपी तैयार करने के लिए शासन स्तर से कंसल्टेंट नियुक्त किया जा चुका है। एमडीपी के प्रतिनिधि मी. मेहतब आलम तथा कु. उमंग हण्डू यहां का दौरा कर चुके हैं।

जिलाधिकारी की अध्यक्षता में को-ऑर्डिनेशन के निर्धारण को एक बैठक भी हो चुकी है। इसमें तय हुआ कि सीडीपी को मुख्यवस्तुत्व रूप से डेवलपमेंट दिशा-निर्देशों के आधार पर ही तैयार किया जाये। सात दिन के अंदर इम्पेक्शन रिपोर्ट बनानी है। सीडीपी तैयार होने तक एमडीपी का प्रतिनिधि लगातार आगरा में मौजूद रहेगा। जिससे शासन की 'प्रथम आगत प्रथम पावत' की केन्द्रीय नीति के आधार पर धन स्वीकृति में विलम्ब न हो।

योजना से सम्बद्ध निगम के अधिशासी अभियंता सुरेश चन्द्रा के अनुसार, सीडीपी तैयार करने वाली टीम के लिए निगम परिसर में ही कार्यालय संबंधी सुविधाएं तथा जरूरी रिकार्ड उपलब्ध कराने का प्रयास है।

उल्लेखनीय है कि प्रदेश में एकमात्र आगरा मण्डल के ही दो शहरों को जेएनयूआरएल योजना में शामिल किया गया है। मधुग के सीडीपी को तैयार करने के लिए भी शासन द्वारा कंसल्टेंट नियुक्त किया जा चुका है।

ताजनगरी के विकास की रूपरेखा

आगरा। ताजनगरी के विकास के लिए बनाई गई सीडीपी वास्तव में शहर के भावी विकास की रूपरेखा को तय करेगी। इसमें भावी विकास की दिशा और दशा दोनों को एक लक्ष्य देने की क्षमता है। इसके लिए पर्यटन को ही आधार बनाने की योजना है। यदि ऐसा होता है तो आगरा अंतरराष्ट्रीय सुविधाओं से संपन्न महानगर हो सकता है।

यह कहना था यूथ हॉस्टल में सोमवार को एमडीपी और नगर निगम के संयुक्त तत्वावधान में आयोजित सीडीपी पर कार्यशाला में भाग लेने आए विशेषज्ञों का। दिल्ली से आए विशेषज्ञ प्रो. प्रो. पीएसएन राव ने बताया कि जेएनयूआरएल के अंतर्गत सीडीपी 2021 तक की जरूरत को ध्यान में रखकर बनाया गया। 12 लाख से ज्यादा आबादी होने के कारण आगरा बी कैटेगरी में शामिल है। उन्होंने बताया कि प्रोजेक्ट का उद्देश्य आगरा में बेहतर इंफ्रास्ट्रक्चर बनाते हुए यहां का आर्थिक रूप से विकास करना है। इसमें कोशिश होगी कि औद्योगिक और सर्विस सेक्टर का विकास हो सके।

उन्होंने कहा कि कोर इश्यू टूरिज्म है। 160 मोन्यूमेंट होने के बाद भी पर्यटक जुड़ नहीं रहे हैं। सड़क मार्ग ठीक न होने के कारण कई स्थानों पर पर्यटक नहीं जाते। विशेषज्ञ उमंग हांडू ने ताजनगरी की समस्याओं के निदान के बारे में बताया। इसके लिए शहर को क्लोन, ग्रीन बनाने पर जोर दिया गया। उन्होंने

सुझाव दिया कि हेरिटेज वाक बनाकर आसपास के इलाकों को स्मारकों से जोड़ना होगा। उन्होंने बताया कि 2021 तक आगरा को 489.4 एमएलडी पानी की आवश्यकता होगी। सीवरों के लिए भविष्य में 313.12 एमएलडी क्षमता के ट्रीटमेंट प्लांट की जरूरत होगी। इसके लिए नाले बनाने जरूरी हैं। साल्टड वेस्ट मैनेजमेंट के लिए 2021 तक 1116.35 मीट्रिक टन कूड़ा होगा।

कार्यशाला में नगर आयुक्त न्याम सिंह यादव, अपर नगर आयुक्त केपी त्रिपाठी, अधिशासी अभियंता सुरेश चंद्रा, नगर स्वास्थ्य अधिकारी डॉ. शमशेर सिंह, सिटीजन कार्टिसिल के डॉ. आरएस पारीक, पीके जैन आदि ने भाग लिया।
