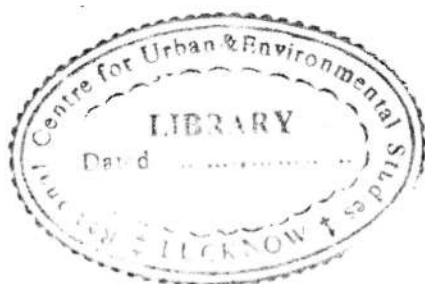

The sixth annual report on the activities of the Regional Centre for Research and Training in Municipal Administration set up by the Ministry of Health, Family Planning, Government of India, relates to the period 1973-74. The Centre has completed six years of its existence.

Director

Dr. R. B. Das, Professor and Head, Department of Public Administration, continued as Director and Member-Secretary of the Advisory Committee.

Chairman Advisory Committee

During the period under report, the Centre had three Chairman in succession. Sri M. U. Ahmad was Chairman till 28th September, 1973. He was succeeded by Sri Ghulam Husain who was Chairman upto 8th December, 1973. In the end of the year Sri Atahar Husain became the Chairman.

Members

Dr. Baljit Singh, Dean, Faculty of Arts was succeeded by Dr. K. N. Shukla. Sri S. K. Chaudhary, Mukhya Nagar Adhikari, Lucknow was succeeded by Sri M. U. Ahmad.

Training Programme

During the year two training courses were organised. The first course of the year and fifteenth in the series, was inaugurated by Sri A. K. Mustafy, Vice-Chancellor, Lucknow University, on September 4, 1973. Its closing function was presided over by Sri Raja Ram Singh, State Minister for Local Self-Government, Madhya Pradesh, on October 13, 1973. The course was attended to by 18 municipal officers whose names are given in Appendix 'A'.

The second training course and sixteenth in the series, was started on November 19, 1973. The closing function, held on December 17, 1973, was presided over by Sri Dharam Dutt Vaidya,

Minister for Local Self-Government, Uttar Pradesh. The course was attended to by 19 newly recruited executive officers of different municipal boards. The list of participants is given in Appendix 'B'

Seminar

The Centre organised a two-day Seminar on 'State-Local Relations' on October 12, 1973. It was inaugurated by Prof. V. K. N. Menon, former Director of the Indian Institute of Public Administration, New Delhi. The names of the participants are given in Appendix 'C'.

Research

The Centre has undertaken the study of the Administrative History of Class I towns of Uttar Pradesh. The District Gazetteers do touch upon briefly the history of the towns, but a detailed analysis of the municipal administration of these towns is not included. It is proposed to take into account the forces that shaped the growth of Class I towns in the State. The Executive Officers of these towns have also been associated with the write up. A proforma for the study has been prepared and two conferences have been held to review progress and make suggestions for the study. A list of the participants in these conferences is given in Appendix 'D'. The collection of material is in progress.

Training Programme : An Evaluation

During the last six years of its existence, the Centre organised sixteen In-service Training Courses and one Orientation Course for the elected representatives of the Urban Local Bodies. In all, 297 municipal officers from the participating states have been trained in these courses. Out of a total of more than 1600 personnel of centralised services in Uttar Pradesh, only 220 have been trained so far.

These courses have been attended to by the personnel of Administrative, Engineering, Education, Health, Audit and Accounts Services.

Attachment

The trainee officers were sent for attachment to the following places :—

1. 15th Training Course—Hyderabad.
2. 16th Training Course—(1) Roorki, Saharanpur, Rishikesh, Dehradun and Haridwar
(2) Ujjain, Khajuraho, Bhopal and Indore.

The participants of the 15th Training Programme studied the working of the Municipal Corporation of Hyderabad. During the 16th Course, the participants were divided into two batches and were attached to the various Corporations/Nagar Palikas as per details given above.

Syndicate Reports

The trainees were required to prepare syndicate reports based on their study, mutual discussion etc. The topics assigned for

writing syndicate reports during these courses were :

15th Course— (i) Powers and Functions of the Executive Officers in Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh.

(ii) State Control over Local Bodies in Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh.

16th Course— (i) Municipal Taxation.

(ii) Municipal Budgeting.

Case Studies

The trainee officers submitted a few case study reports based on their personal experience with the help of model case studies supplied to them.

Review of Acts and Statutes

The participants of the above two courses were divided in batches for reviewing the Municipal Acts, Statutes, Manuals and Bye-laws of the three states.

Diploma in Urban Government and Administration

The course is proving useful and has been started with a view to provide necessary pre-service training to such candidates who wish to enter local government service.

Library

To cater to the growing requirements of trainee officers and research workers in the field of local government, urban planning and allied areas, a separate section has been created. This section has been strengthened considerably through grants from the Central Government and also from the Government of Uttar Pradesh. The Library has also started indexing of micro-literature.

Buildings

The construction work of the Trainees' Hostel-cum-Guest House and Renovation of the existing building of the Centre has almost been completed. The extension of the dining hall and construction of two additional guest suites is in progress.

Grant from the Government of Madhya Pradesh

The Government of Madhya Pradesh has sanctioned a recurring grant of Rs. 5,000/- this year also vide G.O. No. 4350/IF Contg/783/73 dated July 27, 1973. This is gratefully acknowledged.

Budget

The Budget Sub-Committee of the Advisory Committee in its meeting held on October 19, 1973 approved the budget of the Centre as given in Appendix 'E'.

A brief Note on the Activities of the Centre during the Fourth Five Year Plan period

During the Fourth Five-Year Plan period, the Centre conducted 16 training programmes, ten seminars and ten conferences besides one orientation course for the non-officials of the local bodies of Uttar Pradesh.

The Centre also conducted research studies on the following subjects :

- (i) Organisation and working of Select Utility Services in Lucknow
- (ii) The working of municipal corporations in Uttar Pradesh
- (iii) Second municipal corporation elections in Uttar Pradesh
- (iv) Centralisation of municipal services in Uttar Pradesh
- (v) Under-assessment of property tax in Lucknow city
- (vi) Urban Integrated Project (sponsored by UNICEF).
Under this project the following surveys were taken up in the selected area of the project :
 - (a) Socio-economic survey
 - (b) Dietary survey
 - (c) Clinical survey
 - (d) Vocational training and guidance
 - (e) Educational survey
 - (f) Slum improvement survey

Problems and suggestions

Although we have been able to build up the required infrastructure, which is not a mean achievement and is something to be proud of, at the same time, the quality of training and research need improvement. The participation of the municipal officers in various courses was not satisfactory resulting in the increased overhead cost on training. Efforts made by the Centre in the past could not meet with much success. More attention and support of the participating state governments is, therefore, needed to strengthen research and training programmes. The Government may appoint a committee of persons connected with district and municipal administration to look into the process of nomination and suggest method for its effectiveness. For improving the quality of research and training, the posts of middle level staff, such as readers and senior research officers, need to be created.

The Centre has conducted only one orientation programme for municipal chairman/vice-chairman and members of the local bodies in Uttar Pradesh which was encouraging for both, the participants as well as the Centre. There is, therefore, a need to organise more orientation programmes for the non-officials in order to acquaint them with the statutory provisions and functioning of the local bodies.

Due to shortage of staff, adequate number of studies could not be taken up as well as detailed analysis of several aspects in the studies already taken up was not done. On the research side also, therefore, there is a need to increase the staff at the middle level which could undertake projects independently.

The financial position of the Centre has become critical. Revised grades of the staff have added a burden of about Rs. 50,000/- annually. But the Government of India grant has, instead, been reduced. This has resulted into almost a total curtailment of the programmes. In order, therefore, to keep up the training and research programmes going on proper lines, the Government may kindly ensure that the Centre is not put to financial hardships as at present.
